

Advantanges and applications

Trendy Deluxe tiles permit easy cleaning of food and beverages spill. They also allow modular floor patterns to be easily created and installed. Being homogeneous in composition, the patterns and colours are continuously maintained thoughout the thickness lifespan.

The surface is Polyurethane (PU) coated and no initial waxing is required. Due to the affordable price, Trendy Deluxe can be installed in premises of shopping centres, supermarkets, dormitories, education institutions, offices, production floor, laboratories, anywhere indoor where the above advantages are main considerations.

General Laying Information

Subfloor

Floor covering can be installed over new and existing concrete. Good subfloor is characterized as being smooth, level, dry, structurally stable and free of paint, plaster, oil, grease or any substance that could affect adhesive bonding. Cracks and other irregularities must be patched or levelled with the appropriate materials prior to installation.

Note: Do not lay over substrate that are structurally unstable, soft, sandy or uneven. Areas that are damp or prone to moisture must be treated before installation.

Maintenance

Regular Maintenance

Sweep or vacuum to remove dust and remove dirt with damp mop or cleaning materials.

Periodic Maintenance

Clean flooring with a high speed (450 rpm) machine fitted with an appropriate pad using neutral detergent. Allow to dry and apply liquid emulsion polish for surface protection.
